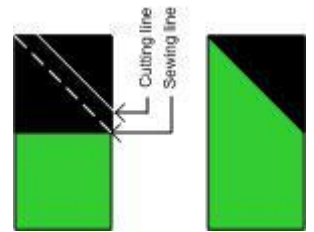


Monster Mash Mystery

Part 3 of 6

CONSTRUCTING SHORT RECTANGLE UNITS

1. Lay 32 of the Fabric 5 (accent fabric) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares face down on your work surface.
2. Mark a diagonal stitching line from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. ►
3. Lay 32 of the Fabric 1 (focus fabric) short rectangles ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ") face up on your work surface.
4. Place a marked accent fabric $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square face down on top of each (i.e. right sides together) as shown in the diagram at the right. ►



Note: Care must be taken to ensure that accent square is placed exactly as shown with the stitching line running from the top left corner to the bottom right corner.

5. Stitch along the marked line; trim off the upper right corner to within $\frac{1}{4}$ " of the seam; press the seam towards the accent fabric.

- **Repeat the above steps using 36 of the accent fabric $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 36 Fabric Group 2 short rectangles ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ").
- **Repeat the above steps using 32 of the accent fabric $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 32 Fabric Group 3 short rectangles ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ").
- **Repeat the above steps using 100 of the accent fabric $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 100 Fabric Group 4 short rectangles ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ").
